

*COUNCIL PROGRESS ANNOUNCEMENT*  
*OUTCOME OF 05/23/2007 SPECIAL MEETING*

The next regular Council Meeting will be on Wednesday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2007 at 6:00 pm.

This meeting was a special closed meeting so that the council could finalize the issue with the employee evaluations and the 2007 Budget. Though the council is not able to share the specifics of the evaluations with everyone, they have been done and passed by council.

Discussion also took place again on proceeding with the 2007 Budget meeting. With the evaluations done and a slight alteration to the look of the budget, the Special Congregation Meeting will be on June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2007 following service. This will be a special meeting to discuss and lay to rest the 2007 Budget. Again, this will be the only item on the agenda and the only item for discussion. No other business will be allowed. To date we have been using the 2006 Budget as a guide and have been doing just fine. As items have come up or have been proposed, the council has discussed and voted on them. We will be sure to get the necessary information out to everyone in a separate mailing outlaying the details.

Ralph brought an update on the bell tower repairs and condition to the council. The leak has been fixed and to complete preventive maintenance on the rest of it, the council with a majority voted to allow RCC Services to complete the re-roofing of the other three corners of the bell tower. The council also agreed to have the leak under the stairs looked at also and hope to get bids soon to take care of that problem.

It was also asked if members who might be interested in attending the next training seminar of the BattleCry program could proceed. The council agreed that this would be a good step at getting our involvement with this program started. More information will be coming on this shortly once it is put together.
